Dr. Jerry Y.S. Lin is Regents' Professor at Arizona State University. He earned his doctorate in 1988 from Worcester Polytechnic Institute after receiving a bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from Zhejiang University in China, and was a post-doctoral staff member at the University of Twente in the Netherlands from 1988 to 1991 when he joined University of Cincinnati as an assistant professor. He was promoted to associate professor in 1996 and full professor in 1998. Dr. Lin joined the faculty of chemical engineering at ASU in 2005, and was Chair of Chemical Engineering Department at ASU from 2006-2009.

Dr. Lin is an internationally recognized leader in research in membrane science with focus on inorganic membranes and adsorbents of materials ranging from microporous to dense ceramics and metals. He has published over 250 journal papers in chemical engineering and material science journals. His papers have been cited about 8000 times (h-index = 51)(SCI data).

In addition, Dr. Lin has advised and graduated 35 Ph.D. students. He received several awards including AIChE Institute Award for Excellence in Industrial Gas Technology in 2009. He is a fellow of both American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) and American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE), and editor of Journal of Membrane Science.
