



Instructions for Full Paper Submissions

Selected full papers from the 9th International Mesostructured Materials Symposium (IMMS-9) will be published in a Special Issue of *Microporous and Mesoporous Materials* and in *Scientific Reports* after the usual peer review processes. Note that there is a limit on the number of papers that can be accepted for the Special Issues, so the editors will select which papers are accepted after review.

The details of the manuscript preparation and submission in a special issue of “Scientific Reports” can be found at <http://www.nature.com/srep/authors/index.html>. All the submitted manuscripts for the special issue will be processed through the peer review system of Scientific Reports, and all papers must pass peer review to be accepted for publication. During manuscript submission, there will be a drop-down menu allowing you to choose the type of article you are submitting. Please choose the option labelled “**Conference Proceedings**”, and then choose the option labelled “**IMMS-9**”. If you do not choose this option, your article will be considered as a normal article submission to Scientific Reports and although it will be considered for peer review it will not be published as part of the conference collection.

Paper submissions for *Scientific Reports* will be accepted until the **15th of October**.

Paper submissions for *Microporous and Mesoporous Materials* are now open and can be submitted until **15th of October 2015**. Information on manuscript preparation and submission for *Microporous and Mesoporous Materials* can be found at: <http://www.journals.elsevier.com/microporous-and-mesoporous-materials/>. Each submission will be processed through the usual peer review system of *Microporous and Mesoporous Materials*, and all papers must pass peer review to be accepted for publication. During the manuscript submission period, there will be an option in the “Choose article type” menu labelled “**SI: IMMS-9 Proceedings**” You must select this option when submitting your paper to have it considered for the conference special issue.
